**Subject: Amendment in Import Policy Condition under ITC(HS) 08028010 of Chapter 08 of ITC(HS) 2022, Schedule –I (Import Policy).**

**S.O. (E):** In exercise of powers conferred by Section 3 and Section 5 of Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992, read with paragraph 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy 2023, as amended from time to time, the Central Government in partial modification to Notification No. 17/2023 dated 03.07.2023, hereby amends the Import Policy Condition (c)(i) of items under ITC(HS) 0802 80 10 of Chapter 08 of ITC(HS), 2022, Schedule – I (Import Policy), as under : **(changes made are in bold letters)**

**Revised Policy Condition:**

(c) Import of 17,000 Metric Tonnes of Fresh (green) Areca Nut without Minimum Import Price (MIP) condition shall be allowed from Bhutan every year. Such imports are allowed:


i) through LCS Jaigaon (INJIGB), LCS Chamurchi(INCHMB), **LCS Hatisar(INHT5B) and LCS Darranga(INDRGB)** only, and,

ii) shall be subject to a valid port-specific Registration Certificate issued by DGFT.

**Effect of the Notification:**

In addition to the existing two ports, import of 17,000 Metric Tonnes of Fresh(green) Areca nut without Minimum Import Price (MIP) condition from Bhutan shall also be allowed through **LCS Hatisar(INHT5B) and LCS Darranga(INDRGB)**.
